- Successful completion of all courses in the Basic Science Program.
Passing score on Step 1 and Step 2 Clinical Knowledge (CK) and Clinical Skills (CS) of the United States Medical Licensing Exam (USMLE).
Successful completion of all required clinical clerkships, consisting of core and elective clerkships as dictated by the IAU Clinical Science curriculum.
All outstanding balances owed to the University must be cleared with the Finance Department.
Complete the Graduation Application and pay applicable graduation fees.
